**3Rs for waste
amount
reduction**

- 1 Let's use it carefully and reduce the amount of garbage!
- 2 Let's use it many times, repair and use it!
- 3 Let's sort for recycling!

REDUCE

1 Do not buy anything that becomes garbage

- Take good care of things
- Bring your own eco bag and your own bottle
- Refuse overwrapping
- Do not buy disposable items

First, let's reduce the generation of garbage.



REUSE

2 Use repeatedly

- Use of returnable container
- Repair and use for a long time

Reuse things repeatedly for a long time without disposing of them as garbage.

RECYCLE

3 If separated properly, garbage becomes resources.

- Observe the sorting rules
- Buy recycled products
- Utilize collective resource collection and over-the-counter collection

If it becomes garbage, let's return it to resources.

3 principles of garbage disposal

Put designated items

Please use the designated bags and sort garbage properly for disposal.



To the designated place

Please check with the neighborhood association etc. for your garbage collection point.



At a designated date and time

Please take it out to the designated collection point by 8 am on the designated day.



If garbage that does not comply with the three principles of garbage disposal is put out at the collection point, the yellow card on the left will be attached to the infringing garbage and it will not be collected.

The reason for the violation is checked on the yellow card, so please take it home once, check the details of the violation, and dispose of it properly at your own responsibility.

The garbage collection point is kept clean with the cooperation of the local people.

Please follow the three principles of waste disposal and cooperate with proper garbage disposal.

Separation of resources and garbage

1 First, separate resources.

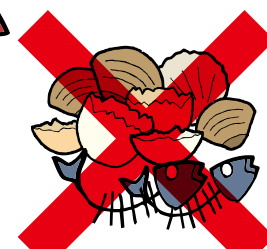
Resources

Raw garbage

- Raw garbage collected in a raw garbage bucket is recycled as compost "Denen Yuki".
- Please be sure to put out the local raw garbage collected in the raw garbage bucket on the day of raw garbage.
- **Please drain thoroughly.** It has a great effect on amount reduction.
- Dispose of non-fermented foods (bones, seashells, eggshells, bean shells, etc.) as "burnable garbage".
- When you put out raw garbage in a plastic bag, please be sure to bring back the empty bag.
- Be careful not to let foreign matter such as vinyl, spoons and forks inside.
- For local raw garbage that is not collected in a raw garbage bucket, try to reduce the amount by using a raw garbage disposal container.

Please do not put bones, seashells, eggshells, etc.

Please drain thoroughly.

What is container packaging?

Plastic containers and packaging and paper containers and packaging **are containers and packaging that you can no longer use or eat the contents of the product.**

A "container" is for putting a product (including a bag), and a "packaging" is for wrapping a product. According to the Containers and Packaging Recycling Law, containers and packaging is defined as "something that is becoming unnecessary when the contents are consumed or separated from the contents."

Made of plastic Containers and packaging

- Plastic containers and packaging are recycled as plastic products such as artificial wood and pallets.
- Check the recycle mark.
- Please take out the ones that are not dirty or wet.
- Dispose of items that are difficult to remove, terrible, or unwashable as "burnable garbage."
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.

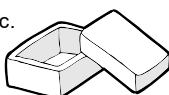

Paper containers and packaging

- Paper containers and packaging are recycled as raw materials for papermaking or recycled paper boards using used paper.
- Check the recycle mark.
- Please take out the ones that are not dirty or wet.
- Dispose of items that are difficult to remove, terrible, or unwashable as "burnable garbage."
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.



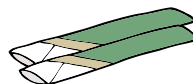

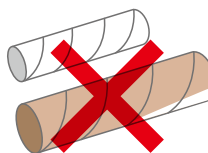

- Please pack and put out each newspaper and magazine within a thickness of 30 cm.
- Please tie it in a cross with a paper string and put it out.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**

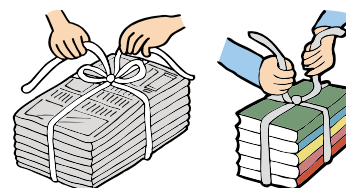

Paper pack

- Paper packs are recycled as toilet paper, tissue paper, etc.
- Check the recycle mark. Paper containers and packaging items with the recycling mark should be put out in "paper containers and packaging".
- Open the container, wash it, put it in a bag and take it out.
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**

PET bottles

- PET bottles are recycled as chemical fibers and PET bottles.
- Check the recycle mark.
- PET bottles with contents cannot be put out. Please empty it and put it out.
- Put out plastic caps and labels in "plastic containers and packaging" and metal caps in "empty cans".
- Please put out containers such as sauce, mayonnaise, ketchup and cooking oil in "Plastic containers and packaging".
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**

Empty can

- Empty cans are recycled as raw materials for iron and aluminum.
- Check the recycle mark.
- Cans with contents cannot be put out. When you take out an empty can, please be sure to empty it and put it in a bag.
- Please be sure to use up spray cans and cassette cylinders, and specify "spray cans" and "cassette cylinders" separately from the bag.
- Please do not put foreign substances such as cigarette butts.
- We do not collect or accept containers for poisonous substances such as pesticides and deleterious substances. Please consult your dealer shop.
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**



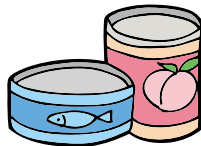

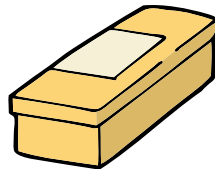

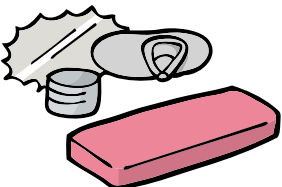

Empty bottle

- Empty bottles are recycled as raw materials for bottles and roadbed materials.
- You cannot put out bottles with contents as garbage. When putting out an empty bottle, please be sure to empty the contents, remove the cap, and put it in the bag.
- Please put out metal caps in "empty cans" and plastic caps in "plastic containers and packaging".
- Please do not put foreign substances such as cigarette butts.
- We do not collect or accept containers for poisonous substances such as pesticides and deleterious substances. Please consult your dealer shop.
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**

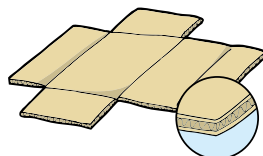
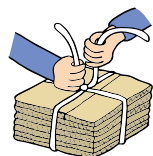


Corrugated cardboard

- Corrugated cardboard is recycled as corrugated board base paper.
- Please check the recycle mark and cross section.
- Corrugated cardboard with surface treatment such as water repellent finish is not recycled. Please put it out as "burnable garbage".
- Fold the corrugated cardboard and tie it in a cross with a paper string.
- **Please give priority to resource recovery at supermarkets and residents' associations.**

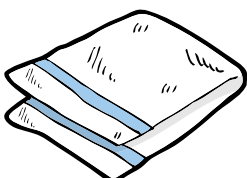


★ Just because it is made of hard paper does not mean that it is corrugated cardboard. Corrugated cardboard has a corrugated cross section.



Old clothes

- Old clothes is recycled as a raw material for textiles and waste cloth.
- Buttons and fasteners can be left attached. Please wash as much as possible before putting it out.
- Please put old clothes in a bag so that the contents do not get wet.



★ Please put old clothes in a bag so that they will not get wet.



2 Next, separate the items to be collected separately.

Collected separately

Small household appliances

- We collect precious metals from small household appliances.
- Remove the dry batteries and dispose of them in "Hazardous / Dangerous Garbage and Dry Batteries".
- **Remove rechargeable batteries such as lithium batteries, insulate the electrodes, and then put them in the collection box of the dealer shop.**
- If the rechargeable battery cannot be removed, completely discharge it before removing it.
- Please dispose of recording media such as CDs and DVDs as "burnable garbage".

Hazardous / dangerous garbage and dry batteries

- Glass, mercury, etc. are collected from fluorescent tubes, and metals are collected from dry batteries.
- Put fluorescent tubes and light bulbs in a bag separate from other garbage so that they will not break, and put them out on the collection day of "empty cans / bottles".
- Please put the batteries, razor, thermometer and disposable lighter in the dry battery collection box provided at the garbage collection point.

* Wrap fluorescent tubes and light bulbs in paper so that they will not break, or put them in a case (paper case for replacement, etc.).

3 Next, separate the garbage that is not separated into resources.

Garbage

Large garbage

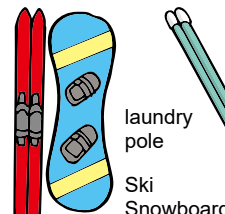
- Metals are collected from large-sized garbage.
- Large-sized garbage has a longest side of 1 m or more, a total of less than 3 m in length, width, and height, a longest side of less than 2 m, and a weight of less than 60 kg. We do not collect anything beyond this, such as electones, organs, pianos, electronic pianos (excluding portables), mattresses with springs, sofas with springs, large and fireproof safes, tatami mats, drums, home tanks, and bathtubs. For details, please refer to "What to request from a collector / What to bring in directly".
- Please put out lightweight flammable items (shelf storage boxes, plastic clothes cases, etc.) with a longest side of less than 1 m as "burnable garbage".
- For large-sized garbage that does not fit in the bag, please attach a note saying "Large-sized / non-burnable garbage" so that people can identify it as garbage.
- Please do not dispose of it as garbage. Instead, please dispose of it by such as selling it to a recycler as much as possible.

★ When you put your bicycle out to the garbage collection point, please paste a note of "Large / non-burnable garbage" so that people can identify it as garbage.



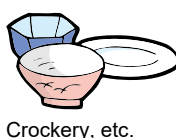
● There are size and weight restrictions.

Length + width + height is less than 3m

- The longest side is **less than 2m**
- Weight is **less than 60kg**

Non-burnable garbage

- Metals are collected from non-burnable garbage.
- You cannot put out bottles with contents as garbage. Please use it up and empty it before putting it out.
- Please wrap crockery ware scraps, flat glass, and broken glassware products in paper, then put them in the bag carefully so that the bag does not tear, and put the bag out as garbage with the contents clearly specified on the bag.
- For kerosene heaters, please be sure to drain kerosene and remove the dry batteries.
- For tube-type lamps, please be sure to remove fluorescent lamps and incandescent lamps before putting them out.
- Please be sure to remove the cassette cylinder before putting out the cassette stove as garbage.
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.

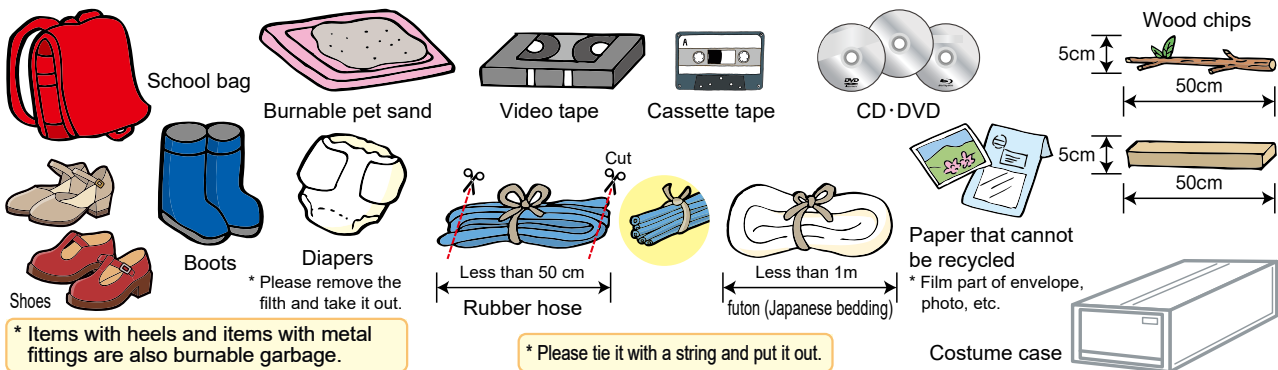

★ Please wrap crockery ware scraps, flat glass, and broken glassware products in paper, then put them in the bag carefully so that the bag does not tear, and put the bag out as garbage with the contents clearly specified on the bag.

Burnable garbage

- Burnable garbage is not recycled. Let's thoroughly separate and try to reduce the amount.
- Please never mix dangerous materials such as metals, spray cans, disposable lighters, fireworks and gunpowder.
- Please harden cooking oil or soak it in cloth or paper before putting it out.
- Wood chips, pruned branches, etc. are accepted only if they are 50 cm or less in length and 5 cm or less in thickness. Items exceeding this size will not be collected or accepted. Please cut it below this and put it out.
- Please dry grass, fallen leaves and pruned branches before putting them in a bag and putting them out at the collection point. If the amount is large enough to bother other people, please separate into several batches and put out 2 to 3 bags at a time.
- Please put it in a bag so that people can know the contents.



Medical waste

Of the medical waste at home, non-infectious waste such as vinyl bags should be labeled as medical waste and disposed of. Please consult a medical institution as you cannot put out sharp objects such as injection needles.

Items not collected

Items that are not collected but are accepted (garbage specified for direct delivery / charged)

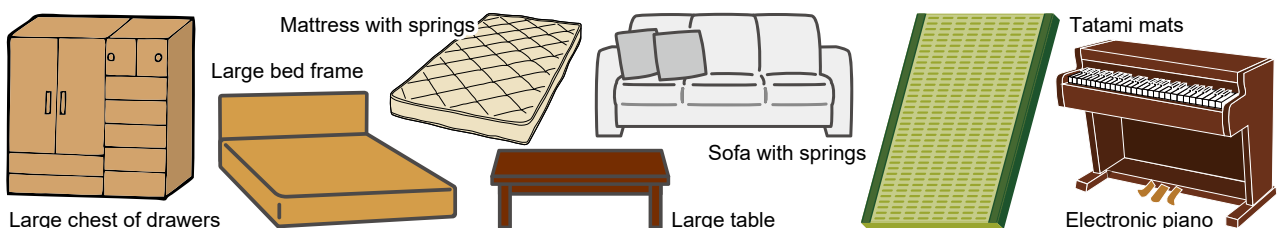
Items that are difficult to collect and transport

The following garbage will not be collected at the collection point. Ask a general waste collection and transportation licensed company to collect it, or make a reservation in advance and bring it in directly. Please check the collection calendar or the union homepage for a list of licensed companies.

(1) Items that cannot be transported (2) Items specified by product name regardless of size

- Items which the total of the three sides (length, width, and height) is 3 m or more or the longest side is 2 m
- Weight over 60kg

Organs, mattresses with springs, sofas with springs, tatami mats, electronic pianos, drums, home tanks, bathtubs, etc. For details, please check the sorting list after P12 or check on the homepage.



Temporary large amount of garbage due to moving, etc.

If a large amount of garbage is temporarily generated due to moving, etc. and the amount is too large to be put out at the collection point (limited to 10 bags or more in 45 liter bags or 1 light truck or more), please ask a general waste collection and transportation licensed company for collection, or make a reservation in advance and bring it in directly by the person who is discharging it.

Chemicals, pesticides and powerful drugs	Please consult with your dealer, retailer, or agricultural cooperative to have them picked up.
Agricultural vinyl	Please have it picked up at the agricultural cooperative.

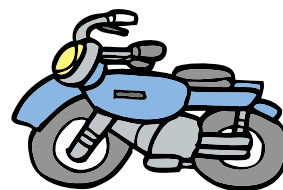
Motorcycles including motorized bikes, and their disposal procedure

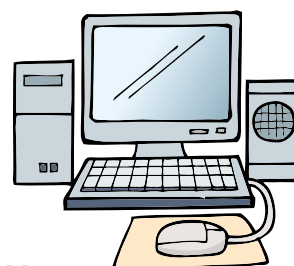

- Based on the Law for Promotion of Effective Utilization of Resources, personal computers (including displays) will be recycled.

Target product

- (1) Desktop personal computer
- (2) Laptop, notebook-sized personal computer
- (3) CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) display
- (4) Liquid crystal display
- (5) Accessories (keyboard, mouse, cable, etc. included at the time of purchase)

 - (3) Please transfer the home appliance recycling fee at the post office and bring it directly to the designated collection place.

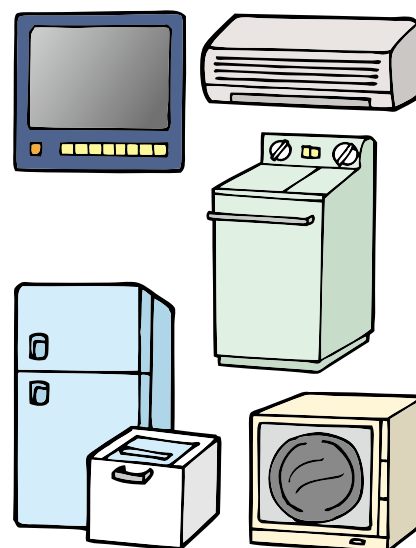
