Non-Collection Days: There will be no collection on May 30, October 31, December 31 to January 3, and January 30.

- 1) By 8:00 a.m. on the designated collection day.
- 2) In the designated place.
- 3) In a proper manner of separation. Put the waste out in a transparent or translucent bag.

Recyclable Waste	Kitchen Waste Wed & Sat	Food scraps/meat/vegetables, etc. Drain food garbage. Discharge into the bucket. "Den-en Yuki" 350 yen (15kg package) Now on sale.
	Plastic Containers/Packages Sat	Containers for tofu, pudding, etc. Recycling symbol for plastic containers. *Please put them out in a transparent or translucent bag.
	Paper Containers/Packages 1st & 3rd Tue	Ice cream containers, etc. Recycling symbol for paper containers. *Please put them out in a transparent or translucent bag.
	Newsletters/Paper Packs/PET Bottles 1st, 3rd & 5th Fri	Paper packs Newspapers Magazines Recycling symbol for paper packs. PET bottles Recycling symbol for PET bottles. Rinse out PET bottles. *Paper cartons and PET bottles should be put out in a transparent or translucent bag.
	Bottles/Cans 2nd & 4th Fri	Cans Recycling symbol for steel cans. Spray cans Recycling symbol for aluminum cans. 1. Fully empty of its contents. 2. Clearly label the bag with "スプレー缶 (Spray Can)". *Please put them out in a transparent or translucent bag.
	Cardboard/Used Clothes 4th Tue	Cardboard Recycling symbol for cardboard. Flatten cardboard and bundle with string. Used clothes Wash in advance as much as possible. *Please put used clothes out in a transparent or translucent bag.
Non-burnable Waste	Over-size/Non-Burnable 1st Tue	[Definition] Items with a total length, width, and height of under 3 m, or under 2 m on the longest side. Skis, snowboards Bicycles Put a note "大形ごみ (Oversize)" on them. Toys (metal) Lithium-ion batteries. Apply tape to the terminals to insulate them. Place in a designated bag separate from other trash and clearly label it "リチウムイオン電池 (Lithium-ion battery)". Any damaged, wet, or swollen items must be brought in directly. *Non-burnable trash should be placed in a transparent or translucent bag.
	Toxic/Hazardous Waste/Dry-Cell Batteries 2nd & 4th Fri	Fluorescent light tubes Wrap up in paper or put in a case for protection. Light bulbs As needed. Razors Thermometers Dry-cell batteries Put into the "Battery Collection Box". Lighters *Please put them out in a transparent or translucent bag.
Burnable Waste	Burnable Waste Mon & Thu	Paper waste Diapers Remove feces from diapers. Large amounts of grass, fallen leaves and cut branches should be disposed of in two to three bags at a time. 5cm x 50cm. Wood waste Smaller than 50 cm long and 5 cm thick. Shoes, bags Eggshells, shells, bones Toys (non-metal) Futons, blankets, etc. Under 1 meter long. Never put in spray cans, lighters, or other prohibited items. *Please put them out in a transparent or translucent bag.

Collected at bases (small home appliance collection boxes)

Small home appliances There are special collection boxes for cell phones, portable radios, telephones, etc. Please put in your unwanted small home appliances. For details, please refer to the Waste Separation Dictionary.

Items to be requested for collection and items to be brought in directly

- Large, non-burnable waste with a total of 3 m or more in length, width, and height, or 2 m or more on the longest side. Examples: Large bed frame, large wardrobe, large table
- Specified items regardless of size: Organ, sprung mattresses and sofas, tatami mats, electronic pianos, drums, home tanks, bathtubs
- Once-off large amounts of garbage

Please make a reservation in advance and bring it directly to the Cleaning Center by yourself, or ask a licensed general waste collector and transporter. (Charged)

- Dead bodies of domesticated dogs, cats, etc. must be brought directly to the cleaning center. (Charged)
- Damaged, wet, or swollen lithium-ion batteries: Directly bring to the cleaning center

The following items are not picked up for collection, or accepted at the Cleaning Center.

- Four household electric items: air-conditioners, televisions, refrigerators / freezers, washers / dryers. Contact: Nippon Express, Morioka Branch Tel: 019-637-6411

- Fire extinguishers Contact: Japan Fire Extinguisher Manufacturers Association Tel: 03-5829-6773
- Rechargeable batteries: Please refer to the JBRC website for details on cooperating stores and collection.
- Electone/piano, large safes/fireproof safes, gas cylinders/propane gas cylinders, commercial stockers, car batteries, car parts (bumpers, etc.) and tires, concrete blocks and bricks, senior cars, thinners, paint, plasterboard, insulation, kerosene, oil, waste oil, tree branches exceeding 50 cm in length and 5 cm in thickness, fireworks, gunpowder, matches, flares, printer ink cartridges, toner, chemicals, pesticides and toxic substances, agricultural vinyl, agricultural equipment and materials
- Motorcycles, including mopeds (less than 50cc)

For disposal destination: Consult the dealer, the handling company, or a licensed general waste collector and transporter. For details, refer to the Waste Separation Dictionary or the website.
